<u>College and Technical school visits</u> – Contact schools you are interested in for program/degree information and to set up a visit. You are allowed 2 college visit days. Complete a college day form and turn in to attendance PRIOR to your visit. Bring proof of visit to attendance upon your return for day to be excused. Also, Fall break

<u>TnPromise</u> – Two years of Community College or Technology Center tuition free (brochure to come) Eligibility requirements:

- 1 Apply between **August 1**st and **November 1**st (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- 2 Attend 2 required meetings October 10th, here at 1:30 and March 20th, here at 5:30
- 3 Complete FAFSA by January 17th (opens October 1st)
- 4 Complete 8 hours of community service spring semester

The window is open, APPLY NOW at **www.tnpromise.gov**. You will need your <u>Social Security number</u> and an <u>email</u> <u>address</u> to register. Application deadline is **November 1**st.

<u>Financial Aide Night</u> – **September 20**th, 6:00 in the Library

- -The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) must be completed in order to receive TnPromise, HOPE, and other financial aid.
- -Application opens October 1st. FAFSA Deadline for the TnPromise is January 17th.

<u>FAFSA FRENZY</u> – **October 12**th in the library. This is an opportunity for parent/seniors to come and have assistance completing their FAFSA.

HOPE (lottery) scholarship – 3.0 GPA OR 21 ACT (brochure to come)

- -Visit www.tn.gov/collegepays for renewal criteria each year.
- -The HOPE scholarship may be use ONLY at approved 2 and 4 year colleges in Tennessee.
- -Freshmen enrolling in a 2 year school for fall of 2017 up to \$1500 per semester
- -Freshmen enrolling in a 4 year school for fall of 2017 up to \$1750 per semester

<u>ACT Retake</u> – Seniors who took an ACT during junior year will be able to retake the ACT on **October 22**nd FREE with a voucher. Deadline to register is **September 16**th. **We will get vouchers out as soon as we have them.**

- ~All seniors should complete a resume. Include everything from 9th grade to present; grades, clubs, service, awards, employment, etc. This will be needed for applications, recommendation requests, scholarships, etc.
- ~Individual senior meetings with Mrs. Lawson to check status for graduation, post high school plans, what you need to be doing, etc.
- ~Dual Enrollment for Spring at Columbia State Students may apply for admission and the Grant now (www.columbiastate.edu) then register for class as soon as the spring classes are posted. Once you are enrolled in a class, bring your Student Detail Schedule to Mrs. Lawson.
